Enhance safety with verified inspections.

Add a layer of safety for officers and your community.

Put an [electronic verified inspection reporting \(EVIR\)](#) system in each officer's hands to perform required inspections and capture the results digitally for online verification.

Ensure each patrol car and special-purpose vehicle is well equipped and safe to drive before every shift. Complete and document post-trip sweeps for contraband or biohazards after unloading prisoners. Extend safety inspections to a variety of fixed locations including holding cell areas, armories and critical supply areas.

Digitize, streamline and verify.

EVIR Mobile is flexible, customizable and available on mobile devices. Officers use the EVIR Mobile app to perform each inspection properly, in less time than paper-based inspection systems, using a standardized, step-by-step process.

1. Select the patrol car or special-purpose vehicle.
2. Review the vehicle's previous inspection results.
3. Open the map view to see each inspection zone.
4. Physically visit and inspect each zone.

Optional: Officers can add photos and/or comments of defects or missing equipment.

Verify inspections in detail.

Once the inspection is finished, results are uploaded to our [secure web portal](#) for online review. Each zone of an EVIR Mobile inspection is timestamped, so you can see when it began, ended and how much time was spent in each zone. Plus, see if any equipment was missing, needs replenishing or was found defective during the inspection.

Review prior inspections.

Officers begin each shift inspection with a view of the vehicle's open defects or missing equipment.

Defects that haven't been closed on the back-end will pre-populate for review at the start. Photos will be also available for reference as they inspect the vehicle.

- Reduce inspection inaccuracies.
- Increase inspection efficiency.
- Open communications between officers, maintenance and supply personnel.

Ensure each vehicle is properly equipped.

Having the right equipment is essential for police officers to perform their duties effectively and safely.

Each zone category lists all the necessary equipment that should be inspected every time. If equipment is running low or missing, officers will mark that in the mobile app and can include comments for clear communication.

Depending on the severity of the equipment, this should trigger the officer to take corrective action before continuing their shift—or alert the designated personnel to restock.

Stay in the know, in real time.

Set up real-time alerts for inspection results that contain documented defects or missing equipment. Add specific vehicles and personnel to the alert subscription so those who need to know are in the loop.

Be notified if an inspection isn't completed. Create an alert subscription for missing inspections. And define thresholds for how many miles the vehicle is driven before the inspection is considered missing.

Reduce risk of vehicle breakdowns.

Instead of waiting on paper forms to be submitted, your fleet management team is instantly notified when a defect is found during an EVIR Mobile inspection.

Keep vehicles healthier and in safe mechanical working condition longer.

- Identify and prioritize major and minor defects more easily.
- Identify and address major issues sooner.
- Schedule maintenance for minor issues ahead of time to reduce unplanned service interruptions in the shop.

Build and customize inspections.

Use Inspection Builder, a back-end feature within EVIR Mobile, to tailor inspections to fit your fleet.

- Modify zone placements and names for each inspection type.
- Edit or remove equipment components.
- Add inspections for special-purpose vehicles.
